Job Overview

As a brewer, your primary focus will be on wort production, but may also involve packaging and cellaring. You will operate as part of a small team working with the head brewer and brewmaster on producing the highest quality product.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Following and adhering to a production schedule
- Operate a direct fire 10bbl - 3 Vessel Brewhouse - Including, but not limited to
 - Grain handling
 - Wort production
 - Record keeping
- Cellar Tasks - Including, but not limited to
 - CIP and SIP
 - Dry hopping
 - Carbonation
 - Yeast management
 - Keg cleaning
- Inventory procedure: Checking in/out inventory
- Equipment and facility maintenance, upkeep and cleaning
- Collaborative recipe development with production team
- Quality Control and off-flavor detection
- Yeast analysis and laboratory testing
- Packaging beer in kegs, bottles and cans
- Managing cellar team tasks when required
- Promoting LAAW at events and festivals (with the team!)
